Environmental Technician – Temporary Contract

Coffee Gold Project, Yukon

Reporting to the Environment Superintendent, the Environmental Technician will perform a range of duties at the Coffee Gold Project including compliance monitoring, contractor supervision, and assisting in the development of the environmental management system. This role requires the candidate to maintain high levels of safety and demonstrate environmental awareness by following all government and corporate regulations and policies. This is a Yukon based contract position and is expected to run from February through to November, but could be extended based on operational requirements. Prior to the site opening up for the season, this position will be based in the Whitehorse office.

Responsibilities

- Compliance monitoring of exploration permits, regulatory requirements, internal standards for related non-conformances.
- Contractor supervision for on-site baseline environmental work including scheduling, logistics, job observation and quality review of work.
- Management of data in environmental databases including data entry, database maintenance, and quality assurance and review.
- Assist in developing internal sustainability program to ensure permit, regulatory and internal sustainability guidelines are met for exploration operations.
- Preparation of regulatory, stakeholder and internal reports.
- On site supervision and development of Environmental Monitors, ensuring safe work practices and supporting individual growth.
- Assist in the development of the Environmental Management system including developing processes and procedural documents aligned with environmental and compliance monitoring.
- Support site operations by planning and delivering environmental training for all staff and contractors on site.
- Provide advice and technical support to site staff, where required on environmental and compliance issues.
- Collection of monitoring data as outlined by permits and regulation.
- Perform maintenance and calibration on environmental monitoring equipment.

Requirements

- 1-4 years of experience in environmental field work
- Prior work experience at a mining/exploration operation highly regarded
- Possession of or willingness to obtain First Line Supervisor certification in Yukon
- Demonstrated excellent work ethic, communication & organizational skills

- Ability to work with staff and contractors in a positive and respectful manner
- Ability to work outdoors in all conditions at a remote site
