Reporting to the Camp Manager, Senior Camp Maintenance will maintain high levels of safety and demonstrate environmental awareness by following all government and corporate regulations and policies. This position is seasonal and is expected to run from March through to November, but could be shorter or longer dependent on drill results. This is an ideal opportunity for applicants interested in gaining experience that could lead to longer term employment on the proposed Coffee mine.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

Maintain Camp facilities:

- Daily tasks may include anything related to the day to day operation of camp and its facilities;
- Repair and maintain onsite equipment as necessary;
- Coordinate and perform any construction projects required for the program;
- Keep radio contact with camp to assist as needs arise;
- Coordinate and provide ground support for crew changes and shipments;
- Any additional assistance in completion of tasks required on-site for the overall objectives of the program, including but not limited to assisting in geotechnical roles.
- Perform duties/tasks while abiding by Goldcorp golden rules and site safety protocols.

Requirements

- Demonstrated excellent work ethic & organizational skills
- Ability to work, outdoors when required, ability to work in noisy, dusty or wet conditions
- Physically fit, able to lift 50lbs repeatedly
- Able to work in a camp setting on a rotational schedule
- Possession of driver's license preferred
- Completion of grade 12 preferred
- Consent to a pre-employment drug & alcohol screening
- Mechanical background/understanding preferred
- Carpentry skills a valuable asset
