Dear Yukon College Student,

The Yukon College Kids' Camps are hosting Spring Break Camps for Yukon College First Nation students. These fully funded week long Camps are free to participants who qualify. Spaces are limited so pre-registration is required.

The Spring Break Camps will be running from March 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup>, and March 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> at the Yukon College Ayamdigut Campus. The Camps are open to First Nation youth of Yukon College students, ages 5 to 13 years old, and will be focused on providing a safe, hands on and inclusive environment for youth to dive into the latest Codemaker Technology available. Lunches will be provided.

Pre-registration will be open to youth that meet the following requirements:

- Parent(s) are First Nation and registered for academic classes (Part-Time or Full-Time) at Yukon College in this academic semester
- Are between 5 and 13 years old

Pre-registration opens March 2<sup>nd</sup> to March 9<sup>th</sup>. After this, the registration for our Spring Break Camps is open to non-First Nation families attending Yukon College with families, and then Yukon College Staff and the general public.

Pre-registration opens this **Friday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> @ 9AM**, and requires a code to register.
