162,456 KM²

Our Traditional Territory covers 162,456 square kilometers of land — 131,599 km² in the Yukon and 30,857 km² in the Northwest Territories.

In early times, our ancestors lived off the land, using the rich supply of game animals, fish, birds, and plants for food and for medicinal purposes. Their lifestyle required travelling throughout our traditional territory at various times of the year, for hunting, fishing, and gathering food to survive.
