**Job Summary:**

Reporting to the camp coordinator the positions are responsible to assist program staff with camp preparation, setup and take down of camp, maintenance and safety, including obtaining and hauling water, cutting firewood, outhouse servicing, preparing fish nets and fish racks, setting up wall tents (if required), removal of garbage during camp and minor camp repairs.

**Main Duties:**

- Setup camp ( kitchen, wash/ out house, trails);
- Pack gear to/ from camp;
- Obtain and haul water daily;
- Cut and pile wood for kitchen and cabins daily;
- Operate chainsaw, as required;
- Haul garbage daily or when needed;
- Assist in cultural camp activities (i.e. set net, haul fish, wall tent setup etc.); and
- Take down camp, ensure gear is packed and everything is stored properly.

- Wilderness First Aid an asset
- Must have knowledge of propane, and generators
- Chainsaw Safety Certification
- Responsible for compliance with WCB safety
- Appropriate safety outdoor gear
