

MOOSE HUNTERS

YOU COULD WIN A CHAINSAW!



The First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun is requesting samples from Moose in NND Traditional Territory as part of a contaminant monitoring program.

All hunters who bring in the requested samples will be entered into a Draw on Nov. 15th, 2018 for a brand new Husqvarna 455 Rancher chainsaw and more prizes!

If you have a successful moose hunt in NND Traditional Territory, please submit the following biological samples to NND Government House before October 31, 2018.

Kidney (whole)

Liver

Muscle

Incisor bar (front teeth)

Each of these should be about the size and shape of a pound of butter.

Each sample should be put in a clean plastic bag and frozen as soon as possible. Samples from different animals should be bagged separately. Record the date, location and sex of the moose.

These samples will be analyzed for a range of contaminants and results will be presented to the community in the fall of 2019
