List of Needs for Camp

- **Sleeping Blanket**
- **Foamy**
- **Pillow**
- **Medicine if any – inform Workers**
- **Medical ID, in case of emergency**
- **Allergy information to be done with Workers**
- **NO ELECTRONICS OTHER THAN A CAMERA**

RULES OF CAMP

1. Respect at all time
2. No rough play, swearing, bullying, name calling, or touching/physical contacts
3. Bed at 11:00pm each night
4. No one leaves camp without an Adult and must let them know where they are at all times.
5. Never leave camp without approval.
6. Adults are not to swear, make bad remarks towards youth, assist happily when needed nor do any discipline let Youth Coordinator know, the Coordinator will deal with all issues in camp towards staff and youth.
7. No Candles to be used at camp, only with adult supervision.
8. Need a fire ask the camp helpers
9. Always in 2's when going to the washroom or shower
10. 1st Aid will be: Camp Maintenance Person
11. Must attend and be up for all programs by 10am each day.
12. Must participate in all activities and programs.
13. No littering in camp
14. Keep bathroom doors closed at all times with seat lid down.
15. Keep cabins clean and tidy and must be cleaned upon leaving-will do a daily cabin check
16. No back talking to Elders, Guest or Workers
17. Must help with the evening chores such as cleaning of the main dining room and dishes. Washrooms, garbage, showers.
18. No horse playing in vehicle while driving
19. No playing or talking during program and activities
20. No ALCOHOL AND DRUGS or Smoking
21. Any problems see - Youth Workers
22. Driver must travel at speed of 90km or less on the Road
23. Chaperones must reside in and near rooms of both Male/Female Youths.
