- Maintain fire suppression equipment
- Clean-up of garbage and hazardous materials
- Assisting with the pickup of food, supplies and water orders
- Abiding by Fire Regulations
- Inventory
- Removing safety risks such as broken barbwire fencing, glass, metals and nails
- In case of fire, carry out suppression and evacuation activities
- Other duties as required by the Fire Smart plan
