| STATUS: out of control. Fire behavior was reduced today due to smoke shading unburned fuel on the fire's north-northeast front. | |
| ACTION: Site protection was completed today at Ethel Lake for all values. Structure protection in Stewart Crossing was completed by wildfire crews and a structure protection task force. | |
| <p>COMMUNITY ALERT STATUS: An evacuation alert has been issued for the area within a radius of 5 kilometres around Stewart Crossing; 12 kilometres south-east to Ethel Lake Road; east to residences around Ethel Lake; and 5 kilometres north of the Silver Trail Highway at kilometre 22 back to Stewart Crossing. An evacuation alert means you need to be ready to leave on short notice. If you leave before or during this alert, it's a voluntary evacuation.</p> <p>The North Klondike Highway and the Silver Trail remain open. The Ethel Lake Road is closed until further notice.</p> <p>The Village of Mayo is not under an evacuation alert. If you have not been contacted by a Wildland Fire official, you are not under an evacuation alert.</p> | |

- Wildland Fire Management crews are monitoring a lightning-caused fire on Hungry Mountain. The fire is 20 km away from Mayo. It does not currently threaten the community, however smoke from the fire is visible.
