The 10th World Conference on Ecological Restoration will focus on the important, and often neglected connection between culture and nature, including the role of restoration in enhancing and rebuilding that connection. The conference theme encourages us to consider our own relationship with nature and the interweaving of human and ecological well-being, as well as to reflect on and pay respect to the deep interconnectedness and reciprocity between nature and Indigenous and traditional communities around the world. SER2023 is being planned in cooperation with SER-Australasia and many other partners in Australia's Northern Territory, the home of the Aboriginal Larrakia people, the Traditional Owners of the area.

Two PhD students, Krystal Isbister (UAlberta) and Caitlynn Beckett (MUN), are organizing a series of presentations on Indigenous-led reclamation projects in northern Canada. FNNND and Yukon Seed and Restoration will be presenting at the conference as part of a mini-delegation. Other presenters include Dena Cho Environmental, Land Guardians from Ross River, the Tłı̨chǫ and potentially Inuit from Nunavik. We're hoping to organize additional opportunities to connect with Indigenous Nations working on mine reclamation, but this hasn't been finalized yet. The conference is an opportunity to bring science and traditional knowledge together in building community development and share the incredible, decolonial work that's happening (not just being talked about!) in the North and get ideas and inspiration from others around the world.
