Are you interested in doing research on FNNND's Traditional Territory or with FNNND Citizens?

Step 1

- Fill out an FNNND research application before starting your research
- Submit the form well in advance of your proposed start date as FNNND review may take time.

Step 2

- Await feedback from FNNND
- If changes are needed, revise the project based on feedback.

Step 3

• If approved:

- You will receive an approval e-mail with the research agreement attached
- Sign in return the agreement to Lauren Baranik.

Step 4

- Conduct your research
- Ensure periodic check-ins with FNNND throughout the duration of your project.

Step 5

- If your project has a signifigant change in scope or requires more time than is stated on the original Research Application and Agreement:
 - Submit another Research Application
 - Repeat the approval process, starting at Step 1.

Step 6

Upon project completion:

- Submit a Final Report outlining your findings and data collected.
- If requested, present your project to the community.

Applicants are only required to provide one Research Application for each project, outlining the proposed duration of the project. If the project requires more time to complete than originally proposed on the Research Application, then the applicant is expected to go through the application process again.
