



Mayo Generating Station Compensation Claim Process

Yukon Energy's existing Water Use Licence (Licence HY99-012) for the Mayo Generating Station (MGS) allows Yukon Energy to use water in Mayo and Wareham Lakes to generate renewable electricity at the MGS. The existing licence expires on December 31, 2025. Yukon Energy is seeking to renew the existing licence for a term of five years.

Compensation related to the five-year licence renewal

People who believe they may be negatively affected by the continued operation of the MGS between 2026 and 2030 may be eligible for financial compensation under the Yukon Waters Act. If you plan to apply for compensation, please review the Yukon Water Board's Operations and Administrations Manual, Appendix C3 – Compensation Guidelines (also available through yukonenergy.ca/mayo). Be prepared to demonstrate:

- any proven or potential loss or damage
- how long and how much you may be affected
- how you use the water
- the level and duration of any nuisance, inconvenience, or noise
- any other information that helps explain the impact on you

Deadline to apply: December 19, 2025

The process for compensation is being led by the Yukon Water Board, not by Yukon Energy. As such, any applications for compensation or questions about the process should be directed to the Yukon Water Board.
