We are looking for **two motivated individuals** to assist with the Stewart River Sonar Program, enumerating **Chinook salmon** on the Stewart River. This Job will require working on weekends and likely 8 to 10-hour shifts. The term would be Mid-June to the end of August.

Position Duties Include

- Monitoring Stewart River water levels
- Physically adjusting the fish-counting sonar and station
- Sonar data compilation and review
- Possible carcass study work at the end of the spawning season
- Assisting with other fisheries-related projects as required
- Supporting the NND Lands, Resources and Heritage Department with additional fisheries initiatives

Work Environment

This position is primarily **camp-based** in and around the **McQuesten Airstrip** area. Work is performed in and near the river, and applicants must be comfortable and knowledgeable working around **fast-flowing waters**. Training is included.

Additional Duties May Include

- Helicopter flights
- Aerial surveys
- River patrols

- Comfortable working outdoors in remote camp settings
- Ability to work safely near fast-moving water
- Physically capable of fieldwork in varying weather conditions
- Interest in fisheries, salmon stewardship, and environmental monitoring considered an asset
- Willing to obtain first-aid
